- What:** Advanced Summer Institute: Geography of Canada - Maritime Provinces
Including content material, classroom activities, atlases, maps and much more!
- When** March 8, 2008 at Western Oregon University, during spring conference

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE INSTITUTE

This institute will include content lectures, model lessons, and fieldwork in Portland and the Canadian Maritime Provinces (Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland and Nova Scotia). Participants will receive materials, model lessons, and maps.

March 8 at Western Oregon University (during the OGA spring conference)

May 17 (all day at either Portland State University or Western Oregon University, to be decided)

July 7 - July 11 at Portland State University

August 1 - August 15 in Canada

GRADUATE CREDIT AND CPD UNITS

Each participant will, upon successful completion of the institute requirements, receive five graduate credits in Geography or Education at reduced rates (\$50.00 per credit hour). Credits will be awarded upon completion of course requirements. 80 CPD units are also available. **All participants must register.**

APPLICATION PROCESS

All TCS, regardless of teaching assignment, are strongly encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to complete applications received by January 31. Selection is competitive and the Oregon Geographic Alliance has complete responsibility and authority for conducting the application and evaluation process and selecting participants for the institute.
